As a professional musician, I hugely enjoy the variety a portfolio career offers. I divide my time between performing, teaching and translating texts about music. The beauty of this work is that each of those elements enhances the other. Being an accomplished player on the recorder can be encouraging, and helps to show people what can be done on the instrument. I am also proficient as a basso continuo player. Variety is one of the key ingredients in a great programme for a playing day. My great love is early music, but I enjoy both performing and conducting music from the mediaeval to the modern. I believe in the power of music, in what it brings to individuals involved in playing it, and am supportive of people taking up the recorder at any age. I have honed my conducting skills since the SRP Edinburgh Branch first gave me the chance to try it out in 2011, and I have recently tutored and conducted at the Recorder Summer School, the Autumn Recorder Weekend, Higham Hall, and the Summer Recorder Festival in Cheltenham. Since 2024 I have also joined Dietrich Schnabel to lead several courses together in Germany.

VENUE

Once inside the front door of the Patchway Community Centre ring the bell marked "Jennings Suite" to the left of the inner front door and wait for someone to buzz you in. Then follow the corridor to the left until you come to the stairs and lift The Jennings Suite is located upstairs. The Suite has its own kitchen and toilets. There are 16 allocated parking spaces outside the Centre, plus plenty of parking just up the road (avoiding the timed bays). Stagecoach bus 12 stops on Rodway Rd near the Community Centre. The 75 bus stop on Coniston Road and the M1 "Fire Station" bus stop on Highwood Road are close by.
